## Provincial Command Insurance Program Vacancy and Protection of Facilities



**The information contained in this bulletin pertains to Legion Branches insured with Programmed Insurance Brokers.**

**Branches not insured with PIB should contact their broker for details on their vacancy exposure.**

Vacancy has been extended under the **program for up to 120 days** from the original declaration of emergency closure in your jurisdiction.

Should your branch re-open between now and 120 days, no further action is required on the part of your branch at this time. (Even a partial re-opening such as operation of a patio would be considered open)

If your branch will remain closed beyond 120 days you will need to notify PIB to obtain a vacancy permit. **If you do not contact PIB to obtain a vacancy permit, your branch will be considered to have re-opened.**

**It is critical that if the Branch will remain closed, you contact PIB prior to the 120-day point to acquire the Vacancy Permit/Endorsement. Otherwise certain restrictions and limitations of coverage may apply.**
