Application for Veteran's License Plate Eligibility Certification



- Important:**
- This application covers only one vehicle.
 - The applicant's name must appear on the vehicle's registration certificate issued by the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ).
 - Only the license plates for vehicles under 3000 kg, touring and motorhome type, can be replaced by a veteran's license plate.

Eligibility Criteria for Veteran's License Plate *(please check applicable box)*

- I served in WWI, WWII or in Korea during the Korean war:
 – As a member of the Canadian Forces; **or**
 – As a member of an allied force, **or**
 – In the Merchant Marine or Ferry Command
- I served for a minimum of three years or I have been serving for at least three years in the Canadian Forces *(paid duty)*.
- I served in NATO operations or as a member of a United Nations peacekeeping force:
 – As a member of the Canadian Forces; **or**
 – As a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, **or**
 – As a member of another Canadian police force, **or**
 – As a member of an allied force.

Proof of service to be included *(please check applicable box)*

You must include a photocopy of the proof of service indicated as corresponding to your situation. The document must be either in English or French; a certified translation must accompany a document in any other language.

- Retired Personnel:** Canadian Forces discharge certificate/certificate of service – both sides (or equivalent for Merchant Marine, Allied forces, etc.).
- Serving Personnel:** A military certification confirming the type of service (regular force or reserve force) and also confirming:
 – receipt of the Canadian Decoration (CD) **or**
 – 3 years (1,095 days) of paid duty **or**
 – involvement in a NATO operation or a United Nations (UN) peacekeeping mission.
- Police Personnel:** Letter from the applicant's police service confirming their involvement in a NATO operation or a United Nations (UN) peacekeeping mission.

Personal information entered on this form is gathered under the Highway Safety Code for the purpose of determining an applicant's eligibility for a veteran's license plate and an updated vehicle registration certificate.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Application for Veteran's License Plate Eligibility Certification

- The applicant must submit the completed and signed application form, along with the proof of service that applies to his/her situation, to the Quebec Command, Royal Canadian Legion at the address given below. A cheque or money order of \$10 made payable to the Royal Canadian Legion, Québec Command to cover administrative costs is also required.
- On receipt of the application, Québec Command, Royal Canadian Legion will validate the applicant's eligibility. If it is confirmed, the application form bearing the branch seal will be sent to the SAAQ. A copy of this form along with the proof of service will be kept by the Québec Command, Royal Canadian Legion. There is no need to go to an SAAQ office, either to submit your application or to obtain your veteran's plate.

Veteran's license plate delivery

- Once Québec Command, Royal Canadian Legion has certified a veteran's eligibility, the SAAQ will issue an updated vehicle registration certificate and veteran's license plate, unless the applicant's record warrants otherwise. In that case, the SAAQ may contact the applicant.
- The plate and the vehicle registration certificate will be sent free of charge, **by mail**, to the applicant's address that appears in the SAAQ files.

**THE LICENSE PLATE MUST BE AFFIXED TO THE VETERAN'S VEHICLE AT ONCE.
THE PLATE CANNOT BE TRANSFERRED EVEN IF THE SAID VEHICLE IS DONATED.**
